

On a more serious matter, the WRA says that the first of the new real estate forms are set to be implemented as of July 1st 2016. Both the WB-1 Residential Listing Contract and the WB-42 Amendment to Listing Contract will be updated. I am told that contrary to past timing, these forms do NOT have an optional use date. According to the WRA, these forms are mandatory to use as of July 1st, but you

could get into trouble if you use these new forms on June 30th before the new law goes into effect (on July 1st). WRA will make these forms available at the appropriate time, but make a note to yourself to switch over to these new forms precisely on July 1st.

## Windows 10 Free Upgrade Ending 7/29 - One Geek's Advice

Microsoft is [employing more forceful tactics](#) to get Windows 7 & 8 users to install the free Win 10 "upgrade" by the July 29th deadline. After that it supposedly will no longer be free though we suspect this may be a bluff, since the reason Microsoft is giving away Win 10 is because it monitors your activity and delivers you targeted ads via the Start Menu and elsewhere. This and [several other reasons](#) are why we previously advised against installing Win 10, and we are still using Win 7 & 8 here. NOTE: If you are still using XP, you should have upgraded two years ago. Time to move on and if your PC is 5+ years old, you may want to look into getting a new one since Win 7/8/10 all need more horsepower than XP - it was a Doozie for many years, but alas XP is now a Dodo.

If you have also resisted Win 10 and wish to continue doing so, make sure to set Windows update to [check but NOT auto-install](#) recommended updates so you can manually choose which to install. You would then need to review the KB article for each recommended update to ensure it's a security update and not a Windows 10 installer. Yes, this is a huge headache so here is a simpler alternative: run [Never 10](#) on your Win 7/8 PC and in a few clicks, it should disable Win 10 notifications and installers permanently.

If you already have Win 10 and would like to disable clandestine activity monitoring, here is a comparison of several tools that may help: [goo.gl/vFBvrO](http://goo.gl/vFBvrO). We must disclaim that NWAR is *not* tech support however, so use any of these tools at your own risk and we *strongly* suggest you backup any important data first. NWAR Members can contact Tech Helpline at 888-804-8225 for free assistance with PC and tablet/smartphone issues.

## MLS Memo

A quick reminder that brokers/agents are responsible for your own data and enforcing its accuracy in displays on portal websites where you choose to send it, such as Zillow. The MLS only makes the data available to them for download with your permission. If you see a problem with a listing on one of those sites, you will need to contact the helpdesk for that site to correct it.

If you do not see an expected listing, first make sure it is marked in the MLS as *Exclusive Right* in the Listing Type field (Exclusive Agency listings are not included in outgoing data feeds). Zillow for example receives listings from many sources other than GNMLS, including franchise and broker direct input. Their latest addition is an Owner Dashboard that allows the homeowner to add or change information. When you log into your Agent account with Zillow you should find their contact info if you need help in making a correction (888-367-4001).

*MLS Tip: Photos from drones are popular and no longer unique; it's more important to post the BEST images possible for each listing.*
