## NAR Triennial Ethics

Some were confused by a recent NAR email re: triennial Code of Ethics training. If you took WRA's CE Ethics course between 2019 and present, then doing so also satisfied the NAR triennial CoE requirement and you can disregard the NAR email. If you received a reminder email from Matt at NWAR however, then you DO still need to complete the free online NAR CoE course by 12/31/21.

This may be because you took CE last biennium with a different CE provider than WRA, and only WRA's CE Ethics course is accepted by the NWAR board to satisfy the NAR CoE training requirement. We therefore encourage real estate licensees to complete WRA's CE4 Ethics course when taking CE next year since that will also fulfill the NAR CoE requirement for the new triennium of 2022-2024.






