Last week the GNMLS Annual Report was sent to all Participants (broker/ owners) in the MLS. Please review the changes in rules and other news of the past year and be sure all your agents are informed. It was certainly an active year with residential sales volume up 48% over the previous year, which was also a record year. Total sales in the MLS surpassed \$900 million!

One item of note requires that cooperation be offered promptly to all fellow members. You may still take an in -house only listing, but it may not be marketed in any way except within your member offices or by one-on-one conversations with customer/clients. To do this, the seller must sign an addendum from our website. Once a listing is entered in the MLS you must be ready to allow showings and other cooperation.

If you are a Broker/Owner, please consider serving on the MLS Board - we need your input.

MLS Tip: Use great care in choosing nondiscriminatory words in your listings to satisfy Fair Housing rules.

Volumes are still way up despite historically low inventory, and medians were up 20.9% for

off-water homes. Medians however were down -7.4% for on-water SFH, -30.8% for offwater land and -11.1% for on-water land. While one month is too short to call a trend, it could be an early sign that buyers are tightening their belts and/or settling for less than their

dream property. The good news is buyer demand remains historically high, but we sorely need supply. After a bitterly cold month of February, maybe now is a good time to ask

owners if they're ready cash out, buy an RV and chase 70 degree weather!
