WRA Partnership for Success Program

The WRA Partnership for Success Program offers support to help ensure new REALTORS from diverse backgrounds thrive in their new career. By forging a partnership between applicant, sponsoring broker and WRA, this program provides startup assistance to applicants from a minority race, color or national origin.

To apply for a Partnership for Success award, both broker and applicant must submit applications and complete an interview with WRA. If granted an award, the recipient receives one year of REALTOR dues *plus* six months of MLS fees. Additionally, candidates who complete the free NAR Fairhaven course and attend the WRA convention or another non-CE course with WRA in their first year are eligible for a 2nd year of free dues.

MLS Memo

Sometimes you need to enter a listing and place it on HOLD due to delayed showings, etc. Be sure to select Internet=NO so it doesn't go out of Xposure before it is ready. When on HOLD be clear in your Agent remarks whether showings are available or not. Access must be equal for the listing firm and other firms. Showings must be available within 72 hours of going Active.

Have you ever entered a listing outside of the MLS office hours and found the road missing? Your best solution is to enter it as "Near" an existing close-by road in the correct municipality. Do not choose a road with the right name but that is in a different municipality. After the road has been added update the listing. This is not wonderful, but the best solution I can think of since we do not have staffing 24/7.

Please remember you may use the Lake or River Name field only if there is owned frontage or deeded access/non-public rights to the waterfront. Otherwise use the remarks to say it is nearby to the lake. Remember to follow ANSI measuring standards: bit.ly/ANSI-101

MLS Tip: In Windows 11, hold Shift as you rightclick on a file or folder to see the full list of options in the context menu.

YTD thru April, medians are up YOY for our region. Looking at just the month of April however, results are mixed. For April-only YOY, off-water SFH medians in our core 7 counties are +21.5% at \$170k with 2.22 MOI or -19% lower. April on-water SFH medians were -7.3% at \$425k however and MOI nearly unchanged.

WRA and NAR both report modestly lower YOY medians in April and slightly higher MOI, but only higher-priced homes in our area mirror that at present. Our market is still strong - in particular for off-water homes.


